This demo will show how to create an "outlay" using a substrate material on the upper or outer edge of a bowl or vessel. Then he'll "inlay" the same substrate material inside the bowl. Finally he'll cutaway the wood surrounding the "outlay" and "inlay" to expose the substrate material 3 dimensionally.

Librarian's Corner

Thanks for voting me back in as Librarian – and thanks to Steve Shaffer for his service to the Library during 2012!

Honor System: Despite the fact that, per an inventory on December 24, 2012, eight resources are missing, and four of our members chose in November to ignore the key Library rule that members are not eligible to sign out additional items if they have not returned previously borrowed items, I am electing to abandon the receipt process previously introduced in favor of an honor system based on trust. I ask that you respect that decision and timely return items, and follow the Library rules that benefit all members. Please recognize that we have only 11 opportunities each year (January through November meetings) to sign out items. I also encourage sharing of items each month among carpoolers or friends – that sharing helps to maximize the usage of the resources. I also ask that you treat Library resources as if you own them – you do – but there is evidence of serious abuse of these resources – and some of them are not replaceable.

Rogues List: I will again be posting at each meeting a "Rogues List" citing, by member name, overdue items and clear violations of Library rules. If particular members choose to repetitively ignore the rules, they risk

having their Library privileges suspended.

Library Resource Listing: My goal will be to ensure that each month, at least one week before the meeting, an updated FRW Library Resource listing (PDF) is posted to our Chapter website. Many new resources were added in 2012 but were not listed as "new," so a close review of the listing before the January 2013 meeting will be helpful to those seeking to maximize their benefit from the Library.

Help Needed: Several of the Assistant Librarians have already committed to continuing to help run the Library in 2013. I simply could not hope to operate without their help. We are looking for more help, and if you are interested in helping out, either contact me via phone or email, or see me at the January 8 meeting.

Uncontrolled Items (Magazines): These are the "Red Dot" magazines. Using this process seemed like a good idea 5 years ago, but we are now overwhelmed with these magazines. We need to find a home for them rather than recycling the paper. I believe they still have value to someone. If you have a home in mind – perhaps a school, or a prison shop – please step forward and volunteer to facilitate transfer of these magazines to that home.

Streamlining Operations. Please bear with us as we streamline our Library operations in our new space at Rockler.
