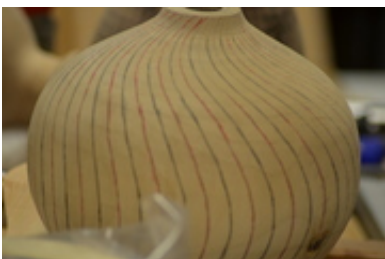
Perpetual Turning
